Staying Safe

- Always handle needles with care—they're sharp and should be treated gently.
- Take your time with each stitch. There's no need to rush!
- If you have a thimble, wear it to protect your fingertips while sewing.
- Keep needles away from little kids, pets, and bare feet.
- When you're done sewing, store your needle safely in its case or pin cushion.
- If a needle breaks, look around carefully and throw away all the broken pieces right away.
- If you accidentally poke your skin, gently clean the spot and put on a bandage.
- These felt treats are just for fun and decoration not for small children to play with.
- If your project gets a little messy, gently clean it with a damp cloth and warm water.
- Never put your felt creations in the washing machine—it can ruin the fabric.
- The supplies in this kit are made just for felt—please don't use them on other materials.

1 Hot ChocolateStuffing3 Sewing Needles

4 Straight Pins
Needle Threader

 Arrange the rainbow and clouds onto the blue circle. Single stitch on using white thread. Set aside for later use.





Single stitch the blue circle (with rainbow)
 onto the large rectangle piece, positioning it
 1/4 inch from the bottom and 1/2 inch in
 from the side.

- Use one small rectangle and two small circles.
- Create a marshmallow shape by blanket stitching one long edge of the rectangle all the way around the edge of the circle to attach them together, then cut off any extra length of the rectangle.



- Blanket stitch the side seam of the rectangle closed to form a cylinder.
- Add stuffing to fill the marshmallow.

- Blanket stitch the second small circle to the open end of the marshmallow.
- Before cutting off your thread, stitch the finished marshmallow onto the brown circle.



 Repeat steps two more times to make a total of three marshmallows.

Handle:

- Use the two long rectangle strips.
- Place them together and blanket stitch around all edges. Set aside.



- Create the mug shape by blanket stitching one long edge of the rectangle all the way around the circle.
- Blanket stitch along the side seam.



• Stuff ¾ of the way.

 Blanket stitch the brown circle (with attached marshmallows) to the top of the cup.



 Fold the top edge of the cup down 1 inch to form a rim.



- Blanket stitch around the top of the fold securing it in place
- Attach the top of the handle to the cup at the seam using a blanket stitch.
- Blanket stitch the bottom of the handle to the bottom edge of the cup.
