

Staying Safe

- Always handle needles with care—they're sharp and should be treated gently.
- Take your time with each stitch. There's no need to rush!
- If you have a thimble, wear it to protect your fingertips while sewing.
- Keep needles away from little kids, pets, and bare feet.
- When you're done sewing, store your needle safely in its case or pin cushion.
- If a needle breaks, look around carefully and throw away all the broken pieces right away.
- If you accidentally poke your skin, gently clean the spot and put on a bandage.
- These felt treats are just for fun and decoration not for small children to play with.
- If your project gets a little messy, gently clean it with a damp cloth and warm water.
- Never put your felt creations in the washing machine—it can ruin the fabric.
- The supplies in this kit are made just for felt—please don't use them on other materials.

Included In Your

Raspherries Blueberries



- 12 Raspberries
- 12 Blueberries
- Stuffing

- Thread
- 3 sewing needles
- Needle Threader



Fold the raspberry piece in half and blanket stitch together.



Turn the project inside out.




Running Stitch along the top edge and add stuffing.

Pull the Running Stitch tight. Close the top.



Bring your needle and thread to the bottom, then pull it all the way up through the center of your project.



Repeat the above step eight times or until desired look is achieved.





Using green thread, Running Stitch around the top of the blueberry.



Add a little bit of stuffing.



Pull the Running Stitch closed.

Add the stem to the top and stitch it in place.
